William Bartram Scenic & Historic Highway

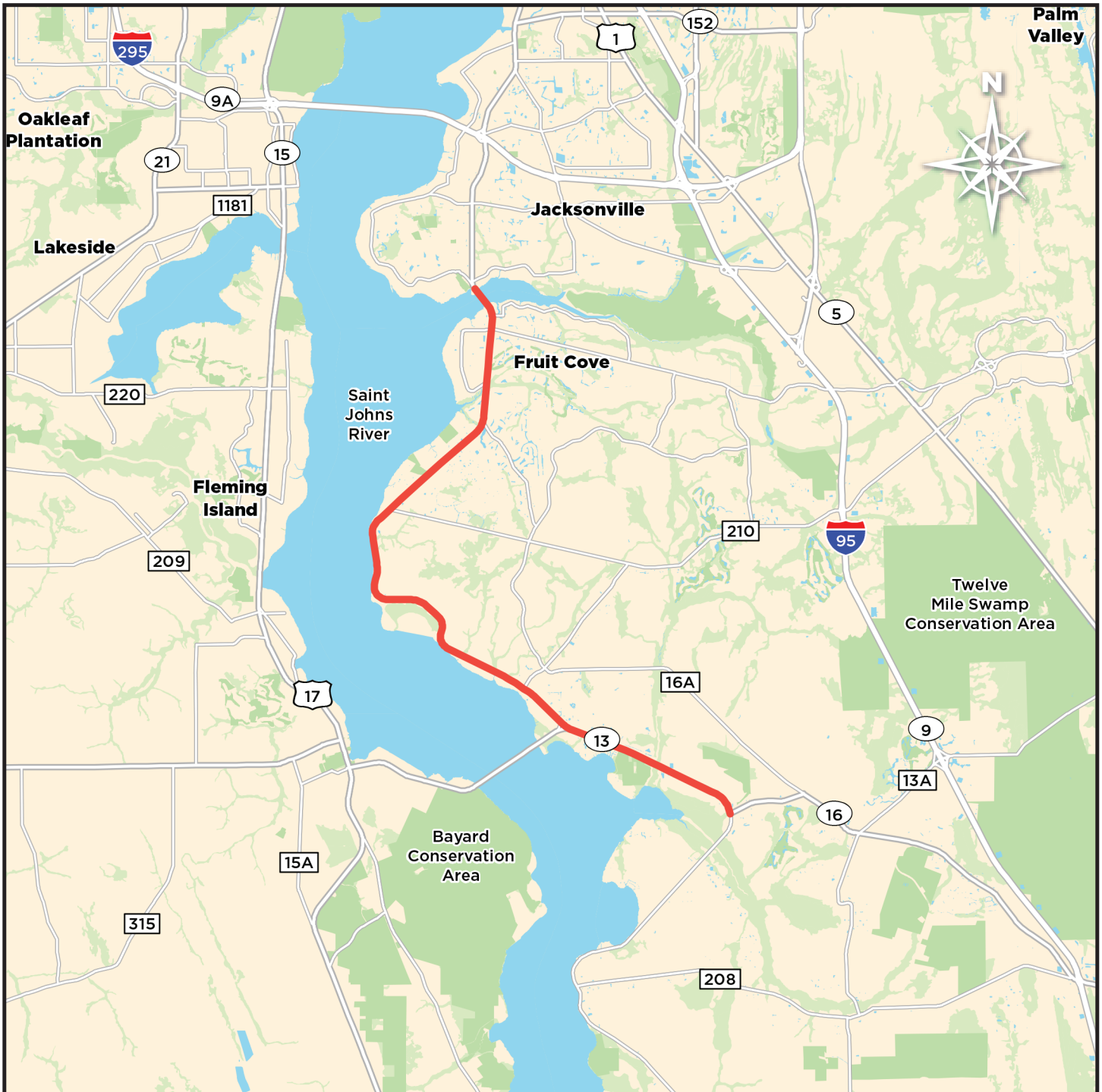
