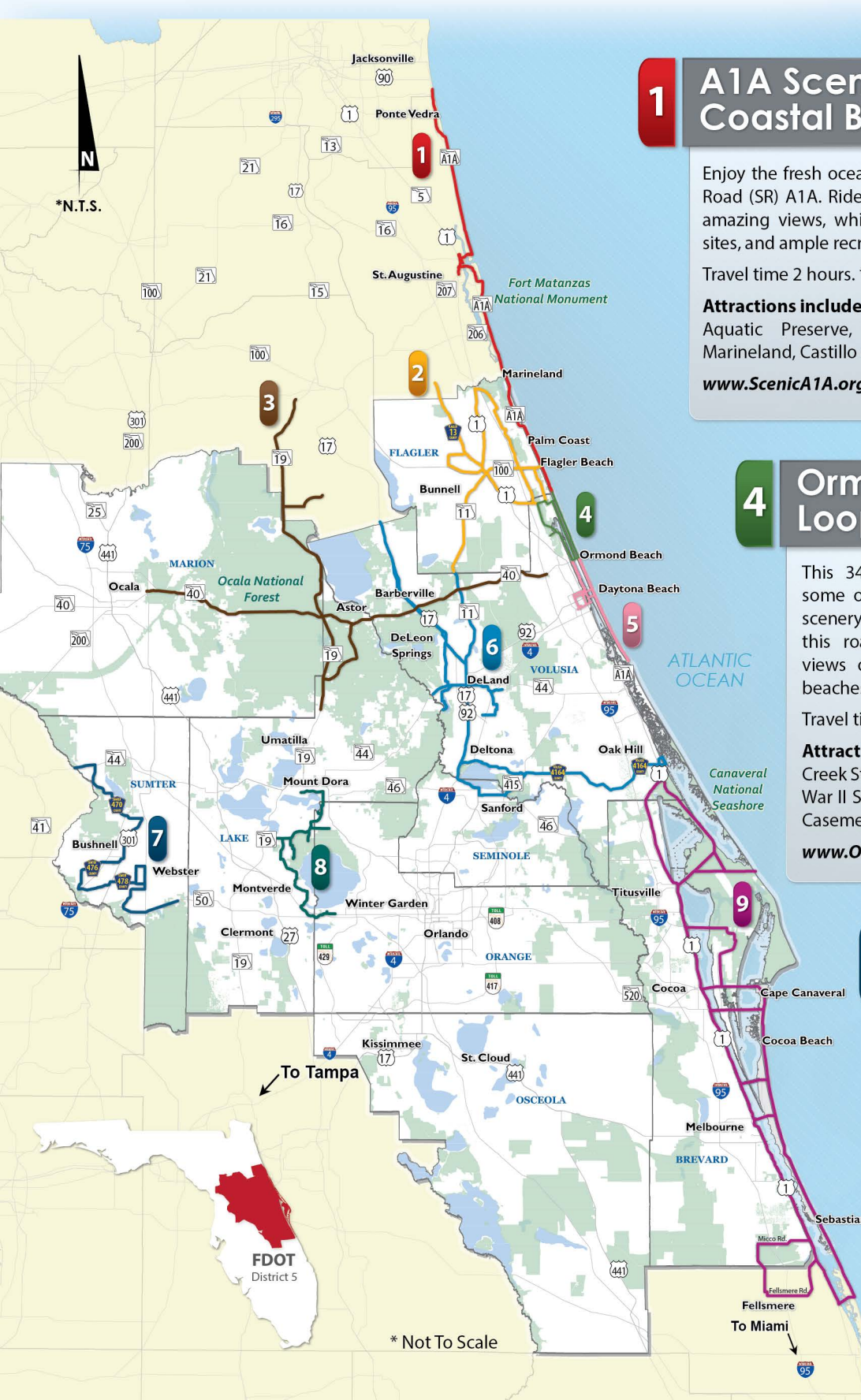

1 A1A Scenic & Historic Coastal Byway



Enjoy the fresh ocean air along this 72-mile section of State Road (SR) A1A. Ride along the Atlantic coast and enjoy the amazing views, white sandy beaches, numerous historical sites, and ample recreational opportunities.

Travel time 2 hours.*

Attractions include: St. Augustine Lighthouse, Pellicer Creek Aquatic Preserve, Ft. Matanzas National Monument, Marineland, Castillo de San Marcos National Monument.

2 Heritage Crossroads: Miles of History Heritage Highway

Discover the history of the area's Native Americans and early colonists while travelling down this corridor's 98 miles of interconnected highways.

Travel time 2 hours and 30 minutes.*

Attractions include: Pellicer Creek Aquatic Preserve, Hewitt's Sawmill, Florida Agricultural Museum, Princess Place Preserve, Bulow Plantation Ruins Historic State Park.

3 Florida Black Bear Scenic Byway



Set in a vibrant landscape of wetlands and pinelands, this 116-mile corridor offers access to world-class resource-based adventures and outdoor learning experiences.

Travel time 1 hour and 30 minutes.*

Attractions include: Alexander Springs, Juniper and Fern Hammock Springs, Salt Springs, Silver Glen Springs, Silver Springs, Sweetwater Springs, Ocala National Forest, Pioneer Settlement for the Creative Arts, Fort Gates Ferry.

4 Ormond Scenic Loop & Trail



This 34-mile double-looped roadway uncovers some of the most beautiful and diverse natural scenery in all of Florida. Have your camera ready as this roadway greets riders with unobstructed views of rivers, marshes, barrier island dunes, beaches, and historic dwellings.

Travel time 1 hour.*

Attractions include: Tomoka State Park, Bulow Creek State Park, North Peninsula State Park, World War II Submarine Tower, The Sugar Mill Ruins, The Casements and Gardens.

5 Halifax Heritage Byway Candidate Corridor

Experience the multi-cultural heritage, history and recreational opportunities along this 35-mile corridor around the Daytona Beach area. Arranged on three community loops, visitors can experience historical sites, beaches, and motor sports racing.

Travel time 1 hour.*

Attractions include: Bethune-Cookman University, Downtown Beach Street Historic District/Riverfront Park, Daytona's World's Most Famous Beach/Boardwalk/ Pier and Daytona International Speedway, Historic Holly Hill, Ponce Inlet Lighthouse, Jackie Robinson Baseball Stadium, Lillian Place and Halifax Historical Museum.

6 River of Lakes Heritage Corridor Scenic Highway

Each stop along this 156-mile corridor offers its own unique glimpses of the past. Ride through historic downtown DeLand and take in the views along the magnificent St. Johns River. This corridor also links with other motorcycle friendly corridors.

Travel time 3 hours.*

Attractions include: Historic DeLand, Blue Spring State Park, Hontoon Island State Park, DeLeon Springs State Park, Lake George State Forest, Lake Woodruff National Wildlife Refuge, Central Florida Zoo and Botanical Gardens, Lake Monore.

7 Scenic Sumter Heritage Byway

Natural beauty and charming small towns await visitors on this 62-mile corridor. Discover pastoral farmlands, cattle ranches, and horse farms. This Byway highlights the scenic view sheds and rich heritage of Sumter County.

Travel time 1 hour and 30 minutes.*

Attractions include: General James Van Fleet Trail State Park, Richloam Wildlife Management Area, Dade Battlefield Historic State Park, Florida National Cemetery, Lake Panasoffkee, Withlacoochee River watershed.

8 Green Mountain Scenic Byway

Located a few miles west of Orlando along the western and southern shores of Lake Apopka, this 45-mile Scenic Byway is an international destination for motorcyclists who come to tour the graceful curves and rolling hills (yes, Florida does have hills).

Travel time 1 hour and 30 minutes.*

Attractions include: Lake Apopka, West Orange and South Lake Bicycle Trails, Mount Dora, Oakland Nature Preserve, Ferndale Preserve, Scenic Overlook and Trailhead.

9 Indian River Lagoon National Scenic Byway



For a ride full of sights, sounds and activity, venture along the Indian River Lagoon National Scenic Byway. Surfing, beaches, birding, hiking, fishing, history, great food, and cultural events await motorcyclists as they explore the 233 miles this Byway has to offer.

Travel time 4 hours.*

Attractions include: Lagoon House Welcome Center, Sebastian Inlet State Park, Kennedy Space Center, Merritt Island National Wildlife Refuge, Pelican Island Wildlife Refuge, Archie Carr Wildlife Refuge.
