1 Ormond Scenic Loop & Trail

Even with some of the most breathtaking roads in the nation, members of the Harley Owners Group (HOG) have declared the **Ormond Scenic Loop & Trail** as one of the favorites among riders in Florida. "The Loop," as locals call it, offers a lush tree canopy that makes it seem like you're riding through a tunnel of pure green wilderness. Ormond Beach is also known as "The Birthplace of Speed," because early autos and motorcycles used to race on its hard packed sand. Although you can no longer ride your motorcycle on the beaches, you can breathe the ocean air as you motor down SR A1A and experience the water and native Florida scrub vegetation that create scenic vistas just waiting to be remembered.

Qreen Mountain Scenic Byway

While the Sunshine State isn't known for hilly terrain, the **Green Mountain Scenic Byway** offers changes in elevation that are rare in Florida. This Scenic Highway features long, rolling hills and a slice of rural Florida. Motorcyclists will enjoy revving their engines and twisting the throttle while traveling up and down the long hill straightaways and taking in the hilltop views, lakeside rides and scenic vistas. If the smell of exhaust isn't the only thing that thrills you, your more delicate side will enjoy the scent of citrus blossoms wafting from the groves in the area. But don't get too captivated by the ride to watch out for the other cyclists. This route also draws bicycle riders from around the world for competition, training and touring.

3 Indian River Lagoon National Scenic Byway

If you're looking for a ride that features majestic natural beauty, motor through the Cape Canaveral National Seashore, located along the Atlantic Ocean and the Indian River Lagoon National Scenic Byway. With plenty of places to stop along the way, this ride offers spectacular views of the ocean and miles of open road, not to mention preservation and conservation lands offering unspoiled views of native Florida. Visit the manatees that frequent the lagoon, or if your eyes are set on the stars, stop at the world-famous Kennedy Space Center to see where history is made and get a first-hand glimpse of what space travel is like.

Florida Keys Scenic Highway

Riders will enjoy the scenery and wildlife (scan the shoulder for gators, snakes and turtles) while traveling along the Florida Keys Scenic Highway. This road is all ease and relaxation with stretches along the water that simply take your breath away. With the soothing turquoise waters of the Gulf on one side and the expansive Atlantic Ocean on the other, you'll travel over more than 40 bridges from Key Largo to Key West. When you've reached Mile Marker 0, you've found the end of the road – the southernmost point in the continental United States. Put your kickstand down at one of the many seafood restaurants, kick your feet up and reward yourself with a famous conch fritter.

5 Scenic Highway 30 G

Breathe in the exhilarating fresh air from the Gulf of Mexico while enjoying the beautiful white sand beaches found on **Scenic Highway 30A**. This area also offers one of the most unique phenomena in the world – its spectacularly rare coastal dune lakes, which are created by the changing of the tides. Along this route, you'll also see a variety of small communities in colorful array – from the vibrant palette of the Caribbean to pastels to quaint white picket fences. Visitors will enjoy the miles of greenway trails that connect the state parks and preserves with the residential areas. You might even catch a glimpse of some dolphins or rare birds on the trip.

6 Tamiami Trail - Windows to the Gulf Coast Waters Scenic Highway

Surround yourself with an eclectic mix of rural openness and urban excitement along the Tamiami Trail – Windows to the Gulf Coast Waters Scenic Highway... perfect for the motorcyclist who would like to experience the best of both worlds. This corridor abounds with scenic vistas and recreational hot spots like the Gulf of Mexico, the Manatee River, the Myakka Wild and Scenic River, and many other beautiful bodies of water. Located in an area known as the Cultural Coast, the communities located along the Tamiami Trail are rich in history and reflect the true essence of Florida's storied past.
